### Entry requirements:

- Entries must come from students (public, private, or homeschooled) in Pasco County. Students can only submit one poster each. Please note, group posters **will not** be accepted.
- Posters must be designed on 11" x 14" or 11"x17" poster-size paper.
- Posters must include a completed label with student's information placed on front or back of poster.
- Posters must include a "Drippy" or "Amie Ba" sticker.
