Entry requirements:

- Entries must come from students (public/private/homeschooled) in Pasco County. Only 1 entry per student!
- Posters must be designed on 11" x 14" or 11"x17" poster-size paper.
- Posters must include a completed label with student's information placed on front or back of poster.
- Posters must include a "Drippy" or "Amie Ba" sticker.

How do I submit posters?
